**OPERATING SURPLUS AND UNRESTRICTED ACCUMULATED SURPLUS**

The 2019 fiscal year ended with an operating surplus for budgetary purposes of \$ 876,573 bringing the unrestricted accumulated surplus to \$1,240,598 as at December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019.
