"Territorial transfer of the municipality of Notre-Dame-de-la-Salette. "

Chelsea, June 18, 2021 - [The study on the financial and administrative impacts](#) carried out by the firm Raymond Chabot Grant Thornton on the transfer of the municipality of Notre-Dame-de-la-Salette from the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais to the MRC de Papineau is now complete and was presented to the Council of Mayors of the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais at the June 17, 2021 session.

This document follows an [initial study](#) on the issues that was conducted by the three municipal institutions with the technical assistance of the Ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation (MAMH), which was officially tabled in February 2021 at the municipal council of Notre-Dame-de-la-Salette, as well as at the council of mayors of the two MRCs.

The council of mayors of the MRC des Collines adopted the following resolution:

- The Council acknowledges the study on the financial impacts of the change of MRC of the municipality of Notre-Dame-de-la-Salette prepared by Raymond Chabot Grant Thornton (RCGT), accepts the conclusions of the said report and proposes to pursue negotiations with the municipality of Notre-Dame-de-la-Salette on the implications of a transfer of regional municipal territory, in collaboration with the representatives of the parties concerned.

"Council is confident that this study will serve as a basis for final discussions regarding the transfer of the municipality of Notre-Dame-de-la-Salette from the territory of the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais to that of the MRC de Papineau. "
